Joan's transition into wound specialization came in 1992 in a research analyst role for the AHCPR Pressure Ulcer Treatment Guideline panel. After becoming a licensed clinical nurse specialist (CNS) and board-certified wound, ostomy and continence nurse (CWOCN), she spent 10 years building the skin and wound program at a 500 bed acute care facility. Since 2008 she provides 8 hour wound seminars in at least three different cities monthly. Joan also provides wound consulting for a hospice program and long-term care facilities in Nebraska.

Committed to sharing knowledge, Joan has published in Nursing Clinics of North America, Nursing 2008 and numerous times in the JWOCN.
